# Battery Installation/Replacement

- 1 Unplug the DT620 from the outlet.
- Use the end of a non-metallic object, such as a pen, to pry the battery holder open.
- If you are replacing the batteries, pry loose the batteries with an end of a paperclip.
- From inside the battery holder, slightly bend the battery contacts outward with a toothpick or small paperclip to increase tension on the new batteries.
- With the prongs facing outward and the holes on the side of the holder facing you, insert a new battery (plus side down), into the battery holder (plus side on bottom).
- Insert the other battery, plus side down, on top of the installed battery.




